[A] Eligibility	Students in first / second year of M.Sc. or 4 <sup>th</sup> / 5 <sup>th</sup> year of Integrated M.Sc. in Physical, Chemical (including Biophysics, Biochemistry, Biotechnology, Nanotechnology, Engineering Physics, Bio-informatics, Chemical Biology, Chemical Engineering, Electronics, Applied Optics & Photonics, Applied Physics, Radio Physics & Electronics, Polymer Science & Technology) and Mathematical Sciences (including Applied Mathematics).
[B] Duration	The project will be for a period of eight weeks (with no break) under the supervision of a Faculty Member of SNBNCBS in an area of mutual interest.
[C] Salient Points	<ul> <li>The programme will be conducted through online mode only</li> <li>Candidates in the second list, if any, will not receive any fellowship from SNBNCBS. They can receive the same from the project of the supervisor, if any</li> <li>Each candidate must submit a formal Joining Report within first day of joining, containing abstract of the project and bank account details</li> <li>Candidates who have INSPIRE or other funding support must inform that clearly in their application.</li> <li>At the end of the project, students are required to give an online presentation of their work and also submit a project report for the award of completion certificate</li> <li>Selected candidates must abide by the rules and regulations applicable to the regular students of SNBNCBS</li> </ul>
[D] Financial Support	The Centre will provide an honorarium of Rs. 1250/- per month to each student (not funded by any other agency) selected for the programme
[E] How to Apply	Interested students with consistently good academic record may fill up the application form (download here) and send the same with requisite documents to <a href="srp@bose.res.in">srp@bose.res.in</a> with a preference list of two Faculty members with whom they would like to be associated. <a href="Note">Note</a> :  (i) Students must contact and get consent of the respective faculty members before sending the application. The list of members of the faculty of the Centre and their fields of research are available in the website of the Centre <a href="www.bose.res.in">www.bose.res.in</a> .  (ii) A letter of Recommendation by the concerned Head of the Department or by a senior member of the Faculty, who has taught the student, should accompany the application.
